

RESOLUTION No. 2012-1952

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALLOCATION OF TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-13

LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Sanitary Board of the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District, Marin County, California, as follows:

1. That the minimum amount of money required by said District to be raised by taxes during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 for the purpose of paying the maintenance and operation expense of said District, as it comes due, is the amount of \$700,000.

2. That it is hereby estimated that said sum is the minimum amount of money required by said District for such purposes during said ensuing fiscal year.

3. That said Sanitary Board further respectfully requests the Honorable Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin to direct the County Auditor to allocate to the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District the amount of \$700,000, or such other amount as shall be determined to be said District's share of the 2012-13 property tax revenue generated pursuant to Section 93 of the Revenue and Taxation Code and allocated pursuant to Section 97 of said Code.
