
Award the Contract to Flatiron for \$51M, with the revised construction documents issued for a project credit negotiation

\$ 51,006,378	Base Bid	Without Alternatives
\$7,389,989 (direct labor & material costs) to \$9,176,023 (with direct burden cost of material tax and labor burden)	Credit Change Order	Flatiron is "already in the room", and will most likely not be willing to fully credit back the approximately \$2-\$3M of OH&P on the "direct cost with burden" Their OH&P on the project is most likely already "set" based on their original \$51M bid.
\$42 – 44M	Probable Project Cost	Dependent on successful credit negotiations. One of the concerns regarding attempting to negotiate a credit change order on this project is the amount of major sub work (electrical, demo, I&C, paving, etc.). Flatiron may be willing to provide a fair credit cost back for their work, but the subs may not which could result in the subs filing claims and lawsuits against Flatiron.

\$51,006,378 (\$56,000,000)	Base Bid	The November 2017 bid cost spread between Flatiron and Kiewit was \$10M. Assume a bid value for the project of "half way" between the "aggressive" Flatiron bid of \$51M and the "conservative" Kiewit bid of \$61M (i.e. \$56,000,000)
\$11,493,605 (with Contractor OH&P) to \$12,642,965 (with Contractor OH&P + 10% Contingency	Revised Contract Drawing Scope of Work	As of 03/25/18, Aqua is continuing to complete the revised contract documents
\$38.5 - \$39.5M (\$43.5 - \$44.5M)	Probable Project Cost
